

## ***Late Night @ WHS: Discovery Core Edition***

**Directions:** The purpose of this assignment is to provide your teacher and classmates with a window into your interests, values, personal history, and personality. In essence, we're asking the question: Who are you? To achieve this goal, each student will be interviewed in a "talk show" format with Mr. Kaufman serving as the host and interviewer.

First, select a 20 to 30 second **introductory musical clip** that can be played on your smartphone as you enter the stage. Also, prepare and submit a **typewritten list of 10 questions** that will be used during your interview. Five of these questions must be selected from the following list; the other five questions should be of your own creation. Exercise care in determining the order in which the questions will be asked. Though you aren't required to write a detailed script of your responses, you will want to rehearse, and will definitely want to think carefully about what you wish to say during the interview.

### **Mandatory Questions (select 5 only).**

1. Given the choice of anyone in the world, whom would you want as a dinner guest? Why? Where would you eat and what would you talk about?
2. Would you like to be famous? In what way?
3. What would constitute a "perfect" day for you?
4. For what and for whom in your life do you feel most grateful? Why?
5. If a crystal ball could tell you the truth about yourself, your life, the future or anything else, what would you want to know? Why?
6. Is there something that you've dreamed of doing for a long time? What is it? Why haven't you done it?
7. What is the greatest accomplishment of your life? Why is it so important to you?
8. What is your most treasured memory? Describe it, and tell us why it is so memorable.
9. Who do you consider your personal heroes? Why are these people worthy of your admiration?
10. If you could change one thing about the world, what would it be? Why?

**Deadlines:** Interviews will begin on **Friday, August 23rd**. All students must select their musical clip and prepare their typewritten list of questions by that date.
