## Late Night @ WHS: Discovery Core Edition

**Directions:** The purpose of this assignment is to provide your teacher and classmates with a window into your interests, values, personal history, and personality. In essence, we're asking the question: Who are you? To achieve this goal, each student will be interviewed in a "talk show" format with Mr. Kaufman serving as the host and interviewer.

First, select a 20 to 30 second **introductory musical clip** that can be played on your smartphone as you enter the stage. Also, prepare and submit a **typewritten list of 10 questions** that will be used during your interview. Five of these questions must be selected from the following list; the other five questions should be of your own creation. Exercise care in determining the order in which the questions will be asked. Though you aren't required to write a detailed script of your responses, you will want to rehearse, and will definitely want to think carefully about what you wish to say during the interview.

## Mandatory Questions (select 5 only).

- 1. Given the choice of anyone in the world, whom would you want as a dinner guest? Why? Where would you eat and what would you talk about?
- 2. Would you like to be famous? In what way?
- 3. What would constitute a "perfect" day for you?
- 4. For what and for whom in your life do you feel most grateful? Why?
- 5. If a crystal ball could tell you the truth about yourself, your life, the future or anything else, what would you want to know? Why?
- 6. Is there something that you've dreamed of doing for a long time? What is it? Why haven't you done it?
- 7. What is the greatest accomplishment of your life? Why is it so important to you?
- 8. What is your most treasured memory? Describe it, and tell us why it is so memorable.
- 9. Who do you consider your personal heroes? Why are these people worthy of your admiration?
- 10. If you could change one thing about the world, what would it be? Why?

**Deadlines:** Interviews will begin on **Friday**, **August 23rd**. All students must select their musical clip and prepare their typewritten list of questions by that date.
